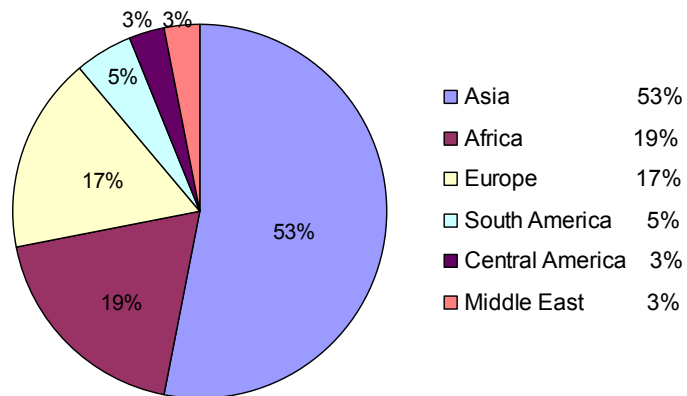

The diagrams below show the population of various parts of the world and their government spending on education.

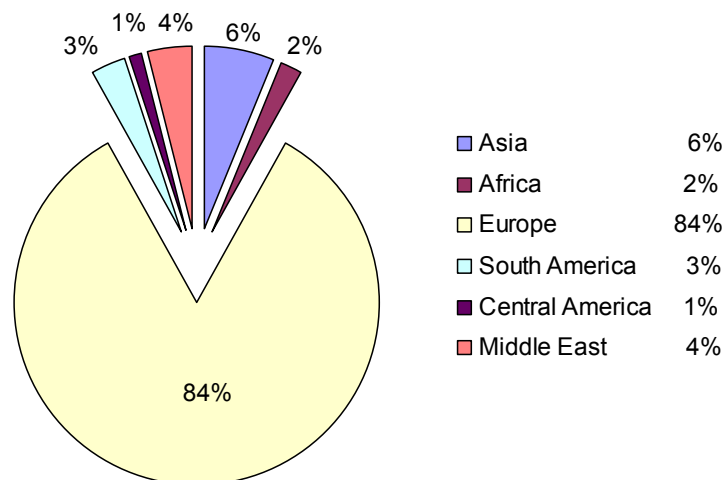

The pie charts illustrate the percentage of the world's population in various regions of the world and government spending on education. As can be seen from the information in the two pie charts, while the highest portion of the world's population is made up of Asian countries, government spending on education is noticeably much higher in European countries.

Firstly, Asia represents the highest population at 53% and only spends a mere 6% on education. The African population, which is at 19%, spends only 2% on education.

In contrast, European countries, which have the third highest population at 17%, spend the highest amount on education at 84%. However, the population of South America is at 5% and spends only 3% on education. Finally, the lower populated parts of the world such as Central America and the Middle East are both at 3% but spend 1% and 4% on education respectively.

From the pie charts it is important to point out that the heavily populated parts of the world such as Asia and Africa spend very little on education, while Europe spends a considerably higher amount on education despite still having a significant percentage of the world's population.
